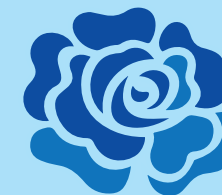

Selection criteria to be able to access the funding.	<p>Young person aged 6 to 16 years of age.</p> <p>The young person is joining a recognised club or school team.</p> <p>Completed application form has been received from appropriate adult.</p> <p>The young person is a resident in Hatfield, St Albans, Welwyn Garden City and surrounding areas.</p> <p>AND/OR</p> <p>The young person attends school in Hatfield, St Albans, Welwyn Garden City and surrounding areas.</p>
The application process.	<p>The Application Form is submitted and acknowledged to the appropriate adult who will receive an Email Confirmation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Within 2 weeks of receiving the application the funding sub group make the decision and communicate the decision to the appropriate adult. • 3 weeks from receipt of application, the decision is shared with appropriate adult. • 4 weeks from receipt of application the funding payment is released.
The approved Funding Criteria	<p>In order to agree the funding all of below need to be in place;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evidence that the young person meets the selection criteria as detailed above. • A fully completed application form has been received (partially completed forms are returned to the sender). • A unanimous decision has been agreed by the funding sub group
Confirming and releasing funds	<p>Funding is made direct to the club or school by bank transfer. Funding for 'kit' will be made to the appropriate adult by bank transfer or cash. Receipts are to be provided following purchase.</p>

An appropriate adult includes; school teacher, school support staff, youth worker, football coach or club secretary, school nurse, social worker

Disclaimer

The Jamie McVeigh Foundation is a small Hatfield based charity that aims to support local young people overcome financial barriers to joining football teams.

Funding is raised through charitable events, supported and run by local people.

Our aim is to be transparent about the process for accessing the funding. The process is detailed in the Jamie McVeigh Funding Framework.

The Foundation works with appropriate adults to support young people in joining a football club.

- The Foundation does NOT work directly with young people or their parents.
- The Foundation does NOT hold on record any personal information about the young people it supports.
- The Foundation will NOT share any personal information about the young people it supports unless there is concern about safety or risk to a young person in which case appropriate information will be shared.
- The Foundation cannot take responsibility for a young person's suitability to join a sports team.
- The Foundation takes in good faith the information provided in writing by the appropriate adult.
- The Foundation cannot take responsibility for the behavior of any individual beyond the Foundation.

The Jamie McVeigh Funding Sub Group decision on the funding is final. There is no option to appeal the decision.

If funding is not successful, applications are welcome the following sporting season (so not in the same 12 month period) if circumstances change.

The funding will be agreed, based on individual merit and as a single application to cover a 12 month period only. A successful funding reward should not be relied on as a continued source or expected in future.

The Jamie McVeigh Funding Framework is reviewed annually.
